

List of Credibly Accused Clergy

On September 30, 2018, the Bishops of the 15 Catholic dioceses in Texas and the Ordinariate of the Chair of Saint Peter made the decision to release names of clergy who have been credibly accused of sexually abusing a minor. This action supports greater accountability and transparency by the Bishops and is another important way to protect children from sexual abuse.

Since its foundation in 2012, the Ordinariate of the Chair of Saint Peter has implemented Safe Environment policies and procedures in all parishes, parochial communities, communities in formation, schools, agencies, and programs. Moreover, the Ordinariate is fully compliant with the requirements as promulgated by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops under the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People and the Essential Norms derived from the Charter.

To date, the Ordinariate has not received any allegation of abuse of a minor made against one of its clergy. Nevertheless, the Bishop has pledged his full support of the decision made together with the Bishops of Texas. Should a credible allegation of abuse be made against a cleric of the Ordinariate, the name of that cleric will be publicly disclosed.
